

## Consent to processing of personal data

*This form is similar to the consent form that you will be asked to sign at the police service point when you register as a voluntary user.*

### 1. Processing operation that the consent applies to

Trial of the Digital Travel Document (DTC) for flights between Finland and Finnair's destinations outside the Schengen area between 17.01.2024 and 31.3.2024.

### 2. Description of the processing of personal data for the purposes of the trial

In cooperation with the National Police Board, the Eastern Uusimaa Police Department and the Finnish Immigration Service, the Finnish Border Guard will test the use of a digital travel document in air traffic between Finland and Finnair's destinations outside the Schengen area between 17.01.2024 and 31.03.2024.

A digital travel document created for the purpose of the trial is not an official travel document. When leaving and arriving in Finland, participants in the trial must carry an official travel document approved by Finland.

The trial assesses

- the creation of a digital travel document based on the data stored on the chip of an existing biometric passport issued by Finland,
- storing a digital travel document in an application installed on the phone of a participant
- sending a digital travel document for inspection by the Finnish Border Guard before travelling; and
- the use of a digital travel document in a border check at Helsinki Airport.

You can register for the trial at designated police stations. At the stations, participants are asked to sign this consent form.

After signing the consent form, the person is identified with a valid biometric passport issued by Finland. Information from the passport chip is read to create a digital travel document with the necessary information. When signing up, a facial photo of the person who gave consent is taken.



Based on the information read from the passport and the facial photo, the registration point creates a digital travel document, which is transferred to the app on the participant's mobile phone with a QR code by having the participant read the code in the app on their mobile phone. The app is free and available for Android and iOS devices in their respective app stores. Only one registration is required for the trial.

The digital travel document is only stored in the app of the participant's mobile phone. This consent form, registration data, and the contact details of the participant are stored in the information system used by the Border Guard and the Police to carry out the trial and to reach the participants. Using the provided contact information, the Finnish Border Guard sends a survey to the participants of the digital travel document (DTC) pilot in order to determine the experiences of using the DTC. Responding to the survey is voluntary.

The application allows a participant to send their digital travel documents to the Finnish Border Guard for inspection before their trip. The Border Guard processes digital travel documents it receives for carrying out border checks in accordance with currently valid legislation. The data contained in the digital travel document will be erased after the flight leaves.

In a border check, a participant may use a separate border inspection desk designated for the trial, in which the person is identified by facial recognition and the validity of their passport is ensured by reading the chip on the passport. If it is necessary to carry out a border check, a normal border check may be carried out on the person.

During the trial period, the Finnish Border Guard, the National Police Board and the Eastern Uusimaa Police Department may disclose personal data processed on the basis of this consent to each other in order to carry out the trial or if there is another legal basis for the disclosure of the data. At the end of the trial period or when a person withdraws their consent, the personal data processed on the basis of their consent will be deleted or anonymised so that the person can no longer be identified.

### 3. Requirements for participation in the trial

You can participate in the digital travel document trial if:

- you are a Finnish citizen,
- you are at least 18 years old,
- you have a biometric passport issued by Finland that is valid until 31.03.2024,
- you intend to travel during the trial period on flights operated by Finnair between Helsinki Airport and destinations outside the Schengen area, and
- you have an Android or iOS smartphone that you can install the trial app on.

### 4. Consent for processing of data

With this consent, I grant the Finnish Border Guard the right to process my personal data as described in this consent form and the privacy statement of the trial, and to disclose them to other authorities participating in the trial. This consent applies to both ordinary and special categories of personal data.

I have read and understood the written notice and privacy statement on the digital travel document trial. I have received sufficient information on the trial and the collection, processing and disclosure of personal data in connection with it. I have had the opportunity to ask questions and have been given adequate answers to all my questions about the trial.

I have had enough time to consider my participation. I have been given sufficient information about my rights, the purpose of the trial and its implementation, and the benefits and risks. I have not been coerced or enticed to participate.

I understand that my participation is voluntary and that I may suspend my participation at any time, or withdraw my consent to the processing of personal data. In revoking my consent to the processing of my personal data, any data collected for the trial will no longer be processed as part of the trial. Instead, they will be deleted or anonymised so that it will not be possible to identify me on the basis of the data. Suspension or withdrawal of consent will have no adverse consequences for me.

## 5. Withdrawal of consent
